Outline	In order to achieve educational goals of the course, it is important to discuss with researchers and other graduate students in the related research fields, along with taking classes. Such discussions are essential for understanding of current status of students' researches in their science fields. For this purpose, this seminar will organize weekly colloquium for the VLBI research group in the field of radio astronomy for the third, fourth, and fifth grade students.
